#### TEMPLATE FOR STUDENT VOLUNTEERS

Introduce yourself, first name, grade, what school you attend.

Explain that you are volunteering for Link Generations to connect with people during this time of social distancing to protect all of us from the spread of the coronavirus. Since you are unable to get together in person, you are writing to connect through this letter/drawing.

Some topics:

- What are you looking forward to doing now that the weather is getting warmer? Why are you looking forward to that?
- What do you like best about springtime? What do you like about it?
- How are you spending your time now that you are out of school for a few weeks?
- What is a funny thing you have heard this week (either in the news, watching an old TV show, from a conversation)? What was funny about it?
- For drawings: set up a still life of a favorite object in your house. Draw it, and explain why it is a favorite.
- If you like drawing outside, draw a scene from your front door. Explain what you see.
